**ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT A CERTAIN PORTION OF PALMER
AVENUE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER YODER,
CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that the Township of Lower Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby accepts as a public highway in the said Township that portion of Palmer Avenue beginning at the northeast intersection of Burly Street and Palmer Avenue; thence eastwardly and southeastwardly to the property now or formerly of Catherine Sauer, a distance of five hundred twenty-four (524) feet, said street being a forty (40) foot street as laid out on the Plan of Lots by Catherine Sauer in the Township of Lower Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, on February 26, 1925, and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cambria County, in Plat Book Vol. 2, Page 116.
