AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ACCEPTING, OPENING  
AND LAYING OUT OF TRUEMAN STREET

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that the Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby accepts, opens and lays out as a public road in said Township Trueman Street, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at Station 0+0 at the intersection of the center line of Mohawk Drive and Trueman Street, thence by the center line of Trueman Street South  $41^{\circ} 39'$  East a distance of 221.10 feet to Station 2+1.10, said point being Station 5+14.90 on center line of Pocahontas Drive as accepted as of this date.

a map, draft and survey showing said Trueman Street and also the center line grade established thereon, as prepared by S. E. Dickey and Company on September 5, 1959 and revised by Hinks and Locher Engineers, Inc. on June 14, 1960, is attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.
