AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ACCEPTING, OPENING
AND LAYING OUT OF MOHAWK DRIVE

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that the Township of Upper Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby accepts, opens and lays out as a public road in said Township Mohawk Drive, being 40 feet in width, having an 8 foot sidewalk on each side and a 24 foot cartway, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at Station 0+0 at the intersection of the center line of Wonder Street, formerly Adams Street, and Mohawk Drive, thence by the center line of said Mohawk Drive South $50^{\circ} 03'$ West a distance of 386 feet to Station 3+86 at the intersection of center line of Truman Street, thence continuing by the center line of Mohawk Drive South $50^{\circ} 03'$ West a distance of 300 feet to Station 6+86 at Antonia Street:

a map, draft and survey showing said Mohawk Drive and also the center line grade established thereon, as prepared by S. E. Dickey and Company on November 21, 1938 and revised on June 13, 1960 by Hinks and Locher Engineers, Inc., is attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

ORDAINED and enacted this 2nd day of January 1961.
