

**RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT PORTIONS OF MINNO DRIVE
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER YODER**

WHEREAS, Ivy Hills, Inc., did in July of 1946, lay out a plot or plan of lots known as Sunnemannor, part of which was in the Township of Lower Yoder; and

WHEREAS, the said plan was approved by the Johnstown Planning Commission on April 7, 1948, and likewise approved by the Borough of Westmont on April 5, 1948, and likewise approved by the Township of Lower Yoder; and

WHEREAS, the said plan is recorded in the Recorder of Deed's Office of and for Cambria County in Plat Book Vol. 4, Page 48; and

WHEREAS, upon the said plan there is a street known and designated as Minno Drive; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention and desire of the Supervisors to accept certain portions of Minno Drive as shown in the said plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township of Lower Yoder accepts the following portion of Minno Drive:

BEGINNING at the intersection of Willett Drive and Minno Drive; thence in northeasterly direction to the intersection of Cinema Drive and Minno Drive, a distance of 1,366.40 feet.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Solicitor be authorized to make written report thereof to be presented and filed in the Office of the Clerk of Courts of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided, that any citizen or freeholder of the Township may, within thirty days after the filing

of the report of the Supervisors, file exceptions to the report, together with a petition for a review.
