AN ORDINANCE OF LOWER YODER TOWNSHIP TO
ACCEPT A CERTAIN PORTION OF WILSON STREET,
HAWS STREET, AVALON AVENUE, BLAWN STREET,
ORANGE AVENUE AND HILLSIDE TRAIL IN THE
TOWNSHIP OF LOWER YODER, CAMBRIA COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that the Township
of Lower Yoder, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby accepts as public
highways in the said Township the following portions of highways:

- (1) WILSON STREET - From the City line approximately
1,585 feet, more or less, northeasterly to a dead
end; it being a forty (40) foot street in width.
- (2) HAWS STREET - From the City line approximately
475 feet northeasterly to a dead end; being forty (40)
feet in width.
- (3) AVALON AVENUE - From Haws Street west
approximately 265 feet; being forty (40) feet in
width.
- (4) BLAWN STREET - From Mountain Road northwest
approximately 300 feet to Orange Avenue; it being
a fifty (50) foot wide street.
- (5) ORANGE AVENUE - Beginning at an unnamed alley
and City line and extending westerly to the inter-
section of Blawn Street approximately 400 feet;
being fifty (50) feet in width.
- (6) HILLSIDE TRAIL - Beginning at Grange Drive
and extending northwesterly approximately 1,045
feet; being forty (40) feet in width.

Said streets being a part of the Sunnymanor Plan of Lots; the
Strayer Plan of Lots; and the Hillside Trail Plan of Lots.
