ORDINANCE #15 TO ACCEPT CERTAIN PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS  
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF CONEMAUGH  
CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained that the Township of Conemaugh, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, hereby accepts as a public highway in the said Township the following described and mentioned streets, roads or lanes as public roads and highways of said Township, and thereafter be and remain the responsibility of said Township for all purposes:

1. That the following streets or roads or portions thereof, as hereinafter described, in the Plan of Franklin extended, as prepared by S.G. Fettermen, C.E., and recorded in the Recorder of Deeds Office in Cambria County in Miscellaneous Book Vol. 10 at Page 481, be accepted by the Township of Conemaugh and become a part of the public road system of Conemaugh Township:

- A. McCard Avenue, 40 feet in width, beginning at the intersection of McCard Avenue with Hornet Avenue and extending 915 feet to the intersection of McCard Avenue with Saratoga Street.
- B. Concord Street, 40 feet in width, beginning at intersection of McCard Avenue with Concord Street and extending 480 feet to the intersection of Concord Street with Hornet Avenue.
- C. Odax Street, 40 feet in width, beginning at the intersection of Odax Street with Lexington Avenue and extending 300 feet to the intersection of Odax Street with McCard Avenue.
- D. Odax Street, 40 feet in width, beginning at the intersection of Odax Street with Luzon Avenue and continuing therefrom a distance of 140 feet to the intersection of Odax Street with second alley.
- E. McCard Avenue, 40 feet in width, beginning at the intersection of McCard Avenue with Odax Street and extending 230 feet to the intersection of McCard Avenue with East Fifth Alley.
- F. Lexington Avenue, 40 feet in width, beginning at the intersection of Lexington Avenue with Essex Street and extending in a northeasterly direction, a distance of 480 feet.

G. Lexington Avenue, 40 feet in width, beginning at the intersection of Lexington Avenue with Hornet Avenue and extending 600 feet to the state highway leading from the Borough of Franklin to state highway route 53.

2. That Ofsanko Lane, 33 feet in width, beginning at the intersection of Ofsanko Lane with Hornet Avenue and extending in a northeasterly direction a distance of 350 feet from said Hornet Avenue and being more particularly described and set forth in Cambria County Assessment Map Book No. 14 at Page 03, be accepted by the Township of Conemaugh and become a part of the public road system of Conemaugh Township.

3. That Kemp Lane, 33 feet in width, beginning at the intersection of Kemp Lane with the state highway leading from the Borough of Franklin to Rager's Corner and extending in a southeasterly direction from said state highway a distance of 1,460 feet to the Richland Township boundary line and being more particularly described and set forth in Cambria County Assessment Map Book No. 14 at Page 07, be accepted by the Township of Conemaugh and become a part of the public road system of Conemaugh Township.

4. That Mizel Lane, 33 feet in width, beginning at the intersection of Mizel Lane with state highway route 53 and extending in a southwesterly direction 850 feet, and being more particularly described and set forth in Cambria County Assessment Map Book No. 14 at Page 02, be accepted by the Township of Conemaugh and become a part of the public road system of Conemaugh Township.

5. A certified and attested copy of this Ordinance shall be filed in the Office of the Clerk of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County.
