ORDINANCE VACATING THE PORTION OF FIFTH STREET
IN THE BOROUGH OF VINTONDALE

ORDINANCE 81

THE BOROUGH OF VINTONDALE hereby ordains as follows:

ALL that portion of Fifth Street located in the Borough of Vintondale, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Griffith Street and Fifth Street; thence along the Westerly side of Fifth Street North $33^{\circ} 58'$ East a distance of 75 feet to a point on the Westerly side of Fifth Street; thence across Fifth Street South $56^{\circ} 2'$ East a distance of 50 feet to a point on the Easterly side of Fifth Street; thence along the Easterly side of Fifth Street South $33^{\circ} 58'$ West a distance of 75 feet to a point on the Northerly side of Griffith Street; thence across Fifth Street on line of Griffith Street North $56^{\circ} 2'$ West a distance of 50 feet to a point on the Westerly side of Griffith Street and place of beginning; containing approximately 3,750 square feet,

be and the same is hereby vacated.

Any ordinance or part of any ordinance conflicting with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Ordained, enacted and adopted this 20th day of December, 1962, by the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths ($3/4$) of the members composing the Council of the Borough of Vintondale.
