Dear Sir:

As Secretary of Geistown Borough Council; I am hereby showing excerpts from a letter dated, Aug. 16th from Representative of the House, Edward W. McNally, as follows:

" I am enclosing herewith House Bills No. 1618, 1617, and 1616 which have to do with the takeover by The State of the street described on Page 6, Lines 15 to 20 inclusive, of House Bill # 1618, in the Borough of Geistown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

" It is my understanding that, in order for this road to be properly taken over by the Commonwealth, it will be necessary for the Borough Council to draw up a Resolution asking for same and forwarding a copy of the Resolution to the Clerk of Courts in Ebensburg Pennsylvania and a copy to the Department of Highways, Attn District Engineer Victor Leopold, Hollidaysburg, Pennsylvania. "

So-Therefore, the following is a copy taken from the Minutes of the Regular Monthly Meeting of Geistown Borough Council on Feb. 14, 1963.

" Council discussed the possibility of having the Commonwealth accept all of Bentwood Street and a portion of 'Old Ohio Street' which remains because of the State, a relocation of 'New Ohio Street'; as an important highway route between State Route 56 and the relocated State Highway, known as Ohio Street. It is the only adequate street existing providing connecting facilities between these two State Routes and although the street is wholly within Geistown Borough, it is bordered by Stonycreek Township.
