REPORT OF SUPERVISORS OF WEST CARROLL TOWNSHIP

In accordance with provisions of Article XI of the Act of May 1, 1933 P. L. 103, as amended, 53 P. S. 19093-1101 et seq. Ernest Powell, John Nalisnick, John Glinsky hereby make the following report:

-1-

That they are the duly elected and qualified Supervisors of West Carroll Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

-2-

That pursuant to a petition of interested citizens, they propose to lay out in the Village of Barnes, West Carroll Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, a road, which portion of road is described as follows:

NO. 1. Beginning at a point, the said point being the Northeast corner of Lot No. 8 on the plot or plan laid out for the Barnes Village, said plan attached hereto; thence along the South side of an unnamed street fronting Lots 8, 10, 12, 14, 16 and across an 18 feet alley in a Northerly direction, being North  $75^{\circ} 05$  minutes East a distance of 320 feet to a point on the Barnes and Tucker Company No. 14 Railroad siding; thence along said siding North  $31^{\circ} 00$  minutes West a distance of 40 feet to a point; thence South on the Northerly side of said unnamed street South  $75^{\circ} 05$  minutes West a distance of approximately 334 feet, the said line above described abutting Lots 17, 15, 13, 11 and 9 to a point on an improved highway in said Barnes Village; thence along said improved highway in a Southerly direction South  $140^{\circ} 35$  minutes East a distance of 40 feet to the point and place of beginning.

NO. 2. Beginning at a point, the said point being the Northeast corner of Lot No. 18 on the plan of lot of Barnes Village on the map hereto attached and made a part hereof; thence along the Northern property line of Lot No. 18, 20, 22, 24, 26 and 28 and a swamp area to the right of way line

of the Barnes and Tucker Company No. 14 Railroad siding North 75° 05 minutes East a distance of approximately 396 feet to the East side of said right of way line of the railroad siding of Barnes and Tucker Company No. 14; thence along right of way line North 140° 55 minutes West a distance of 40 feet to a point; thence South 75° 05 minutes West fronting the South side of an unmarked lot, Lots 29, 27, 25, 23, 21 and 19 a distance of approximately 396 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot No. 19 and the improved highway leading to Bakerton and Spangler; thence along the said improved highway South 140° 55 minutes East a distance of 40 feet to the point and place of beginning.

That the property owners affected by the proposed laying out of said portion of road were given ten (10) days' written notice of a meeting of said Supervisors held on February 3, 1962, at 8:00 A. M. at the Bakerton School located in Bakerton, West Carroll Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, for the purpose of taking action regarding the laying out of said portion of road. Copies of said notices with acceptance of service by each of the affected property owners are hereto attached and made a part hereof.

That after a hearing at the aforesaid meeting, said Supervisors deemed the laying out of the aforesaid portion of road necessary and adopted an ordinance laying out the same as a part of the highway system of said Township. A certified copy of said Ordinance is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "B" and made a part hereof.

That the aforesaid petition of interested citizens and release of damages executed by the owners of the property abutting on said portion of road is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "C" and made a part hereof.

That the aforesaid Ordinance was published prior to its passage in the Johnstown Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation in West Carroll Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the Act of Assembly. Proof of Publication of the same is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "D" and made a part hereof.

WHEREFORE, the aforesaid Supervisors pray that this Report and exhibits attached hereto be filed in the office of the Clerk of Courts of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT A ROAD WHOLLY WITHIN  
WEST CARROLL TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY  
PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, interested citizens of West Carroll Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, have petitioned the West Carroll Township Supervisors, in the interest of public convenience, to lay out, by ordinance, a section of road herein described; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors have decided, in the interest of public convenience, to lay out said section of road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of West Carroll Township and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the petition aforesaid, the following described road be and the same is hereby laid out:

NO. 1. Beginning at a point, the said point being the Northeast corner of Lot No. 8 on the plot or plan laid out for the Barnes Village, said plan attached hereto; thence along the South side of an unnamed street fronting Lots 8, 10, 12, 14, 16 and across an 18 feet alley in a Northerly direction, being North  $75^{\circ} 05$  minutes East a distance of 320 feet to a point on the Barnes and Tucker Company No. 14 Railroad siding; thence along said siding North  $31^{\circ} 00$  minutes West a distance of 40 feet to a point; thence South on the Northerly side of said unnamed street South  $75^{\circ} 05$  minutes West a distance of approximately 334 feet; the said line above described abutting Lots 17, 15, 13, 11 and 9 to a point on an improved highway in said Barnes Village, thence along said improved highway in a Southerly direction South  $140^{\circ} 35$  minutes East a distance of 40 feet to the point and place of beginning.

NO. 2. Beginning at a point, the said point being the Northeast corner of Lot No. 18 on the plan of lot of Barnes Village on the map hereto attached and made a part hereof;

WHEREAS, interested citizens of West Carroll Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, have petitioned the West Carroll Township Supervisors, in the interest of public convenience, to lay out, by ordinance, a section of road herein described; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors have decided, in the interest of public convenience, to lay out said sections of road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of West Carroll Township and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the petition aforesaid, the following described roads be and the same are hereby laid out:

NO. 1. All of that 18 feet wide strip of land lying between the south line of the Benedictine Section and the north line of Lots 19, 21, 23, 25, 27, and 29, beginning on the Bakerton - Spangler Road at the N.W. corner of Lot No. 19 and thence along a line S75° - 05 minutes West to the right of way of Barnes - Tucker Company; thence South through an arc bordering said Barnes-Tucker right of way to a point; thence 293 feet along a line S31° - 00 minutes West to a point; thence N75° - 05 minutes East to the West line of Lot No. 31; together with the "Street" running N75° - 05 minutes East from said Bakerton - Spangler Road to said Barnes - Tucker right of way, same comprising a 40 feet wide strip bounded by the south line of Lots 19, 21, 23, 25, 27, and 29 and the north line of Lots 18, 20, 22, 24, 26, and 28; together with the "Alley" running N75° 05 minutes East from Bakerton - Spangler Road to the Barnes-Tucker right of way, same being an 18 feet wide strip bounded by the south line of Lots 18, 20, 22, 24, 26, and 28 and the north line of Lots 9, 11, 13, 15, and 17; together

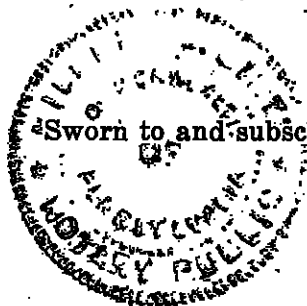

**SECTION 2.** That the Township collector be and he hereby is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance in the office of the Clerk of Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, together with a draft and survey of the roads.

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

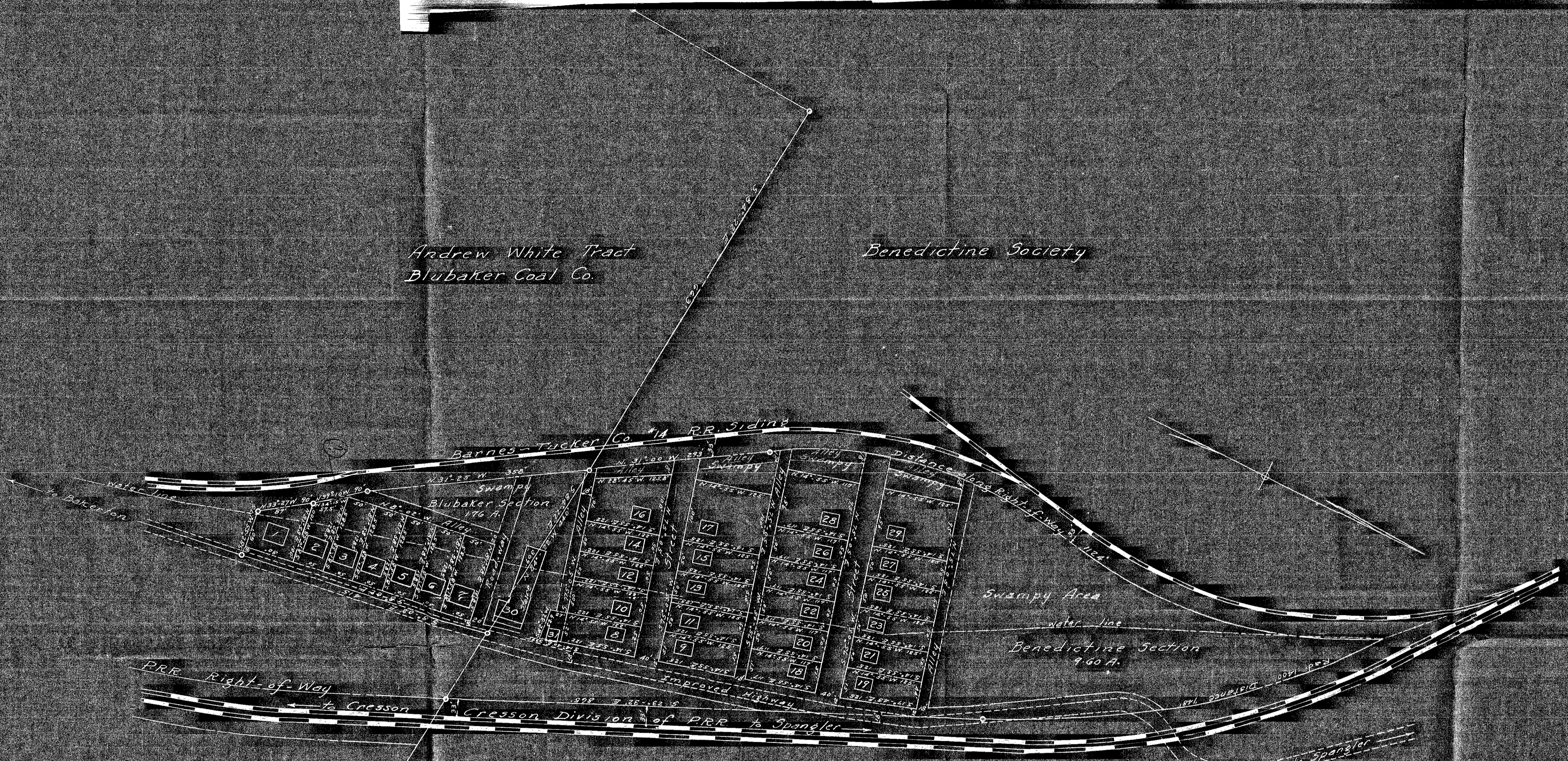
