

ORDINANCE NO. 7

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS A PUBLIC STREET IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST TAYLOR, A STREET TO BE DESIGNATED AS PICKLE STREET, AND FIXING AND REGULATING THE WIDTH AND GRADES THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of West Taylor, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that:

SECTION 1. The following street, which is hereby designated as Pickle Street, is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Township of West Taylor: Beginning from the westerly side of Cooper Avenue and extending by center line which is described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of Cooper Avenue at Station 0+0; thence by the center line of A Street North 60° 00' West a distance of 270.8 feet to Station 2+70.8; thence by the center line of B Street North 29° 32' East a distance of 535.2 feet to Station 8+06; thence by the center line of C Street North 51° 00' West a distance of 330 feet to Station 11+36; thence by same North 46° 00' West a distance of 462.0 feet to Station 15+98, the place of ending.

SECTION 2. The center line grade to be established of said Pickle Street is as follows:

Beginning at Station 0+16 at assumed elevation of 1000.0; thence ascending at the rate of 11.62 feet per 100 feet a distance of 284 feet to Station 3+0 at an elevation of 1033.00; thence ascending at the rate of 08.0 feet per 100 feet a distance of 175 feet to Station 4+75 at an elevation of 1047.00; thence by a vertical curve a distance of 50 feet to Station 5+25 at an elevation of 1049.2; thence ascending at the rate of 1.2 feet per 100 feet a distance of 125 feet to Station 6+50 at an elevation of 1050.78; thence ascending at the rate of 5.04 feet per 100 feet a distance of 125 feet to Station 7+75 at an elevation of 1057.00; thence ascending at the rate of 10.0 feet per 100 feet a distance of 75 feet to Station 8+50 at an elevation of 1064.50; thence ascending at the rate of 14.0 feet per 100 feet a distance of 100 feet to Station 9+50 at an elevation of 1078.5; thence ascending at the rate of 10.5 feet per 100 feet a distance of 100 feet to Station 10+50 at an elevation of 1089.0; thence ascending at the rate of 14.54 feet per 100 feet a distance of 150 feet to Station 12+0 at an elevation

of 1110.7; thence ascending at the rate of 10.3 feet per 100 feet a distance of 200.0 feet to Station 14+0 at an elevation of 1131.30; thence ascending at the rate of 8.9 feet per 100 feet a distance of 100 feet to Station 15+0 at an elevation of 1140.2; thence ascending at the rate of 11.7 feet per 100 feet a distance of 98 feet to Station 15+98 at an elevation of 1151.67 the place of ending.

SECTION 3. The said street shall be 40 feet in width as fully set forth on Plan and Profile of Hinke & Locher Engineers, Inc. dated November 12, 1963, Number 6933-1-33.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the Second Class Township Code.

ORDINANCE NO. 7

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS A PUBLIC STREET IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST TAYLOR, A STREET TO BE DESIGNATED AS PICKLE STREET, AND FIXING AND REGULATING THE WIDTH AND GRADES THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of West Taylor, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that:

SECTION 1. The following street, which is hereby designated as Pickle Street, is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Township of West Taylor: Beginning from the westerly side of Cooper Avenue and extending by center line which is described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of Cooper Avenue at Station 0+0; thence by the center line of A Street North $60^{\circ} 00'$ West a distance of 270.8 feet to Station 2+70.8; thence by the center line of B Street North $29^{\circ} 32'$ East a distance of 535.2 feet to Station 8+06; thence by the center line of C Street North $51^{\circ} 00'$ West a distance of 330 feet to Station 11+36; thence by same North $46^{\circ} 00'$ West a distance of 462.0 feet to Station 15+98, the place of ending.

SECTION 2. The center line grade to be established of said Pickle Street is as follows:

Beginning at Station 0+16 at assumed elevation of 1000.0; thence ascending at the rate of 11.62 feet per 100 feet a distance of 284 feet to Station 3+0 at an elevation of 1033.00; thence ascending at the rate of 08.0 feet per 100 feet a distance of 175 feet to Station 4+76 at an elevation of 1047.00; thence by a vertical curve a distance of 50 feet to Station 5+25 at an elevation of 1049.2; thence ascending at the rate of 1.2 feet per 100 feet a distance of 125 feet to Station 6+50 at an elevation of 1050.70; thence ascending at the rate of 5.04 feet per 100 feet a distance of 125 feet to Station 7+75 at an elevation of 1057.00; thence ascending at the rate of 10.0 feet per 100 feet a distance of 75 feet to Station 8+50 at an elevation of 1064.50; thence ascending at the rate of 14.0 feet per 100 feet a distance of 100 feet to Station 9+50 at an elevation of 1078.5; thence ascending at the rate of 10.5 feet per 100 feet a distance of 100 feet to Station 10+50 at an elevation of 1089.0; thence ascending at the rate of 14.54 feet per 100 feet a distance of 150 feet to Station 12+0 at an elevation

of 1110.7; thence ascending at the rate of 10.3 feet per 100 feet a distance of 200.0 feet to Station 14+0 at an elevation of 1131.30; thence ascending at the rate of 8.9 feet per 100 feet a distance of 100 feet to Station 15+0 at an elevation of 1140.2; thence ascending at the rate of 11.7 feet per 100 feet a distance of 98 feet to Station 15+98 at an elevation of 1151.67 the place of ending.

SECTION 3. The said street shall be 40 feet in width as fully set forth on Plan and Profile of Hinks & Lecher Engineers, Inc. dated November 12, 1963, Number 5933-1-33.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the Second Class Township Code.
