AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT ROADS WHOLLY WITHIN
CRESSION TOWNSHIP, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, the Supervisors have decided in the interest of public convenience, to lay out, by Ordinance, sections of roads, same being parts of private roads.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Cresson Township, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of same as follows:

SECTION I. That the following described roads with widths as hereinafter stated be and the same are hereby laid out:

Boland Drive beginning at Highland Avenue and extending north-easterly a distance of 610 feet to the north side of Grove Avenue and Grove Avenue from the north side of Boland Drive a distance of 317.90 feet to the Township Road leading from Summit to Gallitzin, known as Country Club Road. Said Boland Drive being 50 feet wide and Grove Avenue being 40 feet wide.

Fourth Street beginning at the north side of Guirm Avenue and extending southerly a distance of 1160 feet to the south side of Center Avenue, said street being 50 feet wide.

Center Avenue from the east side of Fourth Street to the west side of Lot No. 177 and street presently owned by Cresson Township a distance of 150 feet. Said Avenue being 50 feet wide.

A print or survey of the roads hereby laid out is shown on plans previously filed in the Office of the Clerk of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County under Cresson Township Road, Docket No. 2, December Sessions 1961, and filed on October 2, 1961.

SECTION II. That the Township Solicitor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance in the Office of the Clerk of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania

SECTION III. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
