ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE LAYING OUT, OPENING AND ADOPTING AS A PUBLIC ALLEY IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST TAYLOR, AN ALLEY TO BE DESIGNATED AS "A" ALLEY, AND FIXING AND REGULATING THE WIDTH AND GRADES THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of West Taylor, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that:

SECTION 1. The following alley, which is hereby designated as "A" Alley, is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public alley in the Township of West Taylor; said alley extending by center line which is described as follows:

Beginning at Station 0+0 at the intersection of the centerline of Natalie Street and "A" Alley, thence by the centerline of said "A" Alley South  $19^{\circ}-39'$  East 331.41 feet to Station 3+31.41, thence continuing by said centerline South  $1^{\circ}-10'$  West 31.36 feet to the Southerly side of connecting 16 foot alley, the place of ending. "A" Alley being 16 feet in width.

SECTION 2. The center line grade to be established of said "A" Alley is as follows:

Beginning at Station 0+10 at an elevation of 1000.00 thence descending at the rate of 0.67 feet per 100 feet a distance of 270.0 feet to Station 2+80 at an elevation of 998.19, thence ascending at the rate of 2.37 feet per 100 feet a distance of 135.0 feet to Station 4+15 at an elevation of 1001.39.

SECTION 3. The said alley shall be 16 feet in width as more fully set forth on Plan and Profile of Hinks and Locher Engineers, Inc. dated May 20, 1966.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the  
Second Class Township Code.

PETITION, GENERAL RELEASE AND QUIT-CLAIM

TOWNSHIP OF WEST TAYLOR, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

We, the undersigned petitioners, hereby petition the Board of Supervisors of West Taylor Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, to accept, approve and establish the grade as set forth by the Plan and Profile appearing on the reverse side of this form and describing Merrett Street in the Township of West Taylor, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and do say:

1. Petitioners are the owners abutting on said street.
2. Said street being more particularly bounded and described in the Township of West Taylor, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

The centerline is described as follows:

Beginning at Station 0+0 at the intersection of the centerline of Naylor Road and the centerline of Merrett Street thence by the centerline of said Merrett Street South 1°-50' West 250.0 feet to Station 2+50, the place of ending. Merrett Street being 50 feet in width.

The centerline grade is hereby established as follows:

Beginning at Station 0+0 at the intersection of the centerline of Naylor Road and Merrett Street at an elevation of 997.06, thence descending at the rate of 0.25 feet per 100 feet a distance of 250.0 feet to Station 2+50 at an elevation of 996.43, the place of ending.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned petitioners, for themselves, their heirs and assigns, in consideration of the advantages accruing to them by the establishment of said grade and the acceptance by West Taylor Township of said street, and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00), hereby grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release and confirm unto the Township of West Taylor, its successors and assigns, all of their right, title and interest in the street as described in preceding paragraph and as set forth on the reverse side of this form for a public street or highway and for no other use or purpose whatsoever.

And the said petitioners, for themselves, their heirs, administrators, executors and assigns, by these presents covenant, promise and agree to and with the said Township of West Taylor, its successors and assigns, that neither the petitioners nor their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, shall or will at any time hereafter ask, demand or recover or receive of or from said Township of West Taylor, its successors or assigns, any sum or sums of money as and for damages for or by reason of the physical grading, paving or resurfacing of said street to the grade as established herein and shown on the Plan and Profile appearing on the reverse side of this form, or for or by reason of the physical widening of said street to the width as now established by the engineer as shown on the Plan and Profile appearing on the reverse side of this form, or for or by reason of drainage as deemed necessary by any engineer retained by West Taylor Township.

Beginning at Station 0+0 at the intersection of the centerline of Natalie Street and "A" Alley, thence by the centerline of said "A" Alley South 19°-39' East 331.41 feet to Station 3+31.41, thence continuing by said centerline South 1°-10' West 171.59 feet to Station 5+03 at the intersection of the centerline of Naylor Road, the place of ending. "A" Alley being 16 feet in width.

The centerline grade is hereby established as follows:

Beginning at Station 0+10 at an elevation of 1000.00 thence descending at the rate of 0.67 feet per 100 feet a distance of 270.0 feet to Station 2+80 at an elevation of 998.19, thence ascending at the rate of 2.37 feet per 100 feet a distance of 135.0 feet to Station 4+15 at an elevation of 1001.39, thence descending at the rate of 1.25 feet per 100 feet a distance of 80.0 feet to Station 4+95 at an elevation of 1000.39, said point being at the intersection of the centerline of "A" Alley and Naylor Road the place of ending.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned petitioners, for themselves, their heirs and assigns, in consideration of the advantages accruing to them by the establishment of said grade and the acceptance by West Taylor Township of said alley, and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00), hereby grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release and confirm unto the Township of West Taylor, its successors and assigns, all of their right, title and interest in the alley as described in preceding paragraph and as set forth on the reverse side of this form for a public street or highway and for no other use or purpose whatsoever.

And the said petitioners, for themselves, their heirs, administrators, executors and assigns, by these presents covenant, promise and agree to and with the said Township of West Taylor, its successors and assigns, that neither the petitioners nor their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, shall or will at any time hereafter ask, demand or recover or receive of or from said Township of West Taylor, its successors or assigns, any sum or sums of money as and for damages for or by reason of the physical grading, paving or resurfacing of said alley to the grade as established herein and shown on the Plan and Profile appearing on the reverse side of this form, or for or by reason of the physical widening of said alley to the width as now established by the engineer as shown on the Plan and Profile appearing on the reverse side of this form, or for or by reason of drainage as deemed necessary by any engineer retained by West Taylor Township.
