ORDINANCE

Number 5

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF READE, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED:

That there be laid-out and opened a public highways the following streets as shown on the plan of the town of Reade, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, which plan is on file and may be examined at the home of Harry L. Wilkinson, Secretary, Reade Township Superintendant, Mandburg, Pennsylvania:

1. A street known as First Street on said plan, 40 feet in width, Beginning at a point on State Highway Route No. 53 and extending North 69° 5' East, 856 feet to the public highway known as State Highway Route No. 10063.
2. A street known as Second Street on said plan, 40 feet in width, Beginning at a point on State Highway Route No. 53 and extending North 69° 5' East, 680 feet to Hill Street.
3. A street known as Third Street on said plan, 40 feet in width, Beginning at a point on State Highway Route No. 53 and extending North 69° 5' East, 670 feet to Hill Street.
4. A street known as Hill Street on said plan, 33 feet in width, Beginning at a point on First Street and extending South 32° 30' East, 570 feet to Third Street.

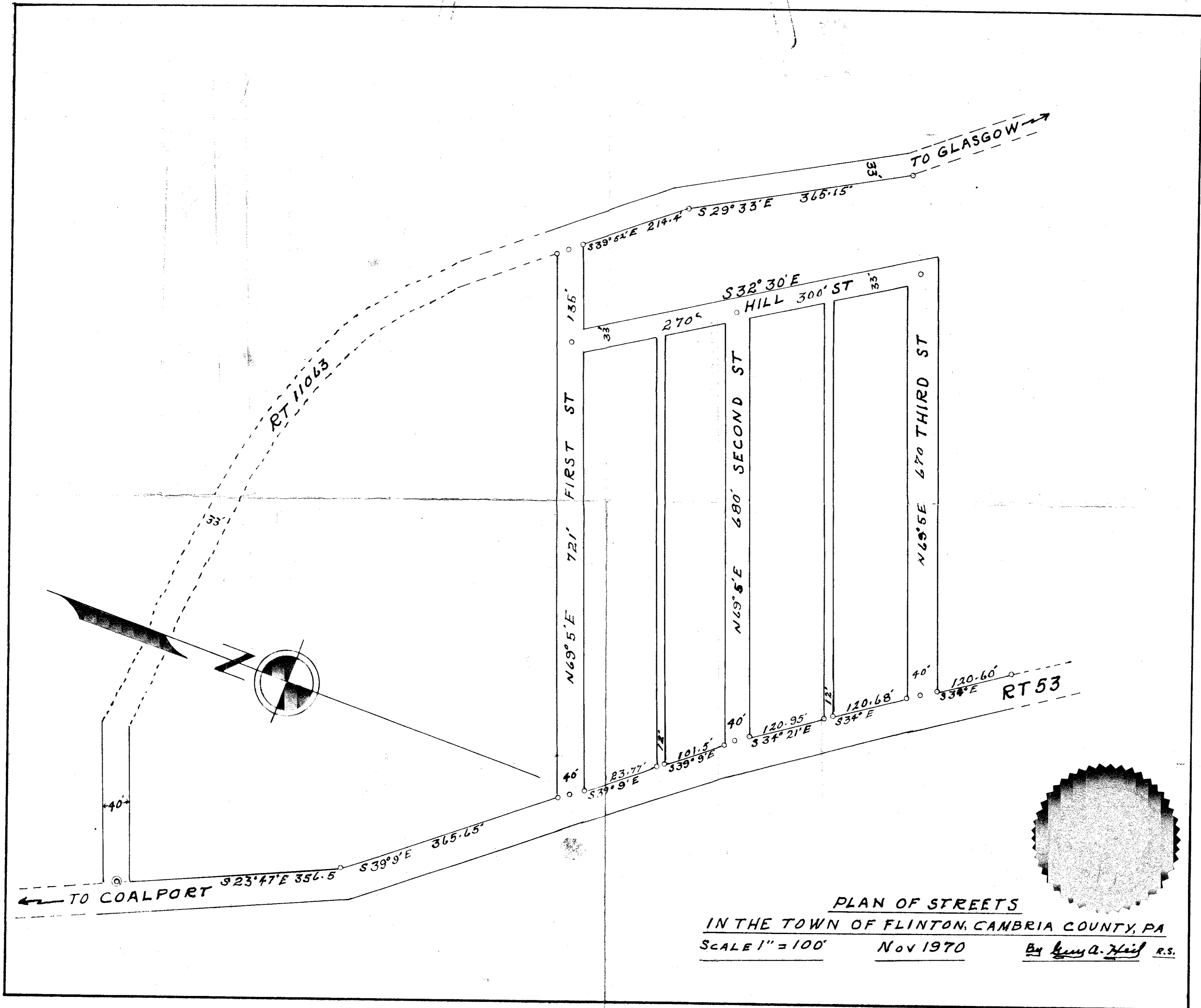
